Both names fit Samuel Ruiz, the bishop of San Cristobal de las Casas in Chiapas. The Mexican government has launched a ferocious media campaign. For almost 40 years, he witnessed the severe oppression of the indigenous people and a "theology of liberation," which, essentially, sided the church with the poor. Outside Mexico, Samuel Ruiz is mostly known for his role in the conflict. Beyond church reform, Bishop Ruiz became one of Chiapas's and "Don Samuel was a leader who walked amidst other people, not in front of them," recalls Father Ituarte.
